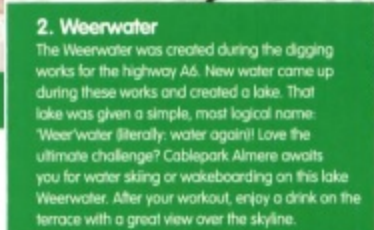
Highlights!

1. Almere Centrum

After your workout, enjoy a drink on the terrace with a great view over the skyline.



3. The Floriade area

2022 the Floriade will take place here. It is a gardening exhibition with exhibitors and visitors from all over the world. The topic for this edition: Growing Green Cities, urban sustainability. For Almere the Floriade is not just another international event. It is much more. A project which will take several years to complete and shall result in a totally new residential area, meant to remain green long after the Floriade is over. A new residential block right at the city centre called Almere Floriade.



4. Stadslandgoed de Kemphaan
